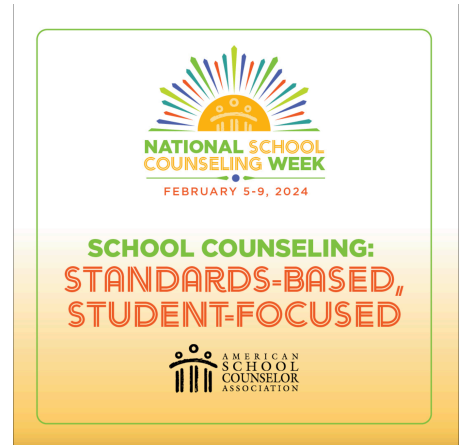

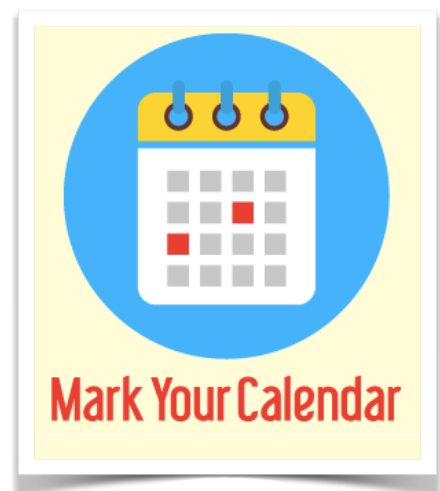
Feb. 15th: Go Purple Day! Wear purple to bring attention to children that are born with congenital heart defects.
