**School News:** Happy September Dorothy Hall Innovators! School is off to an amazing start and the students are doing an excellent job learning their new routines and procedures. Please make sure that you are connected to your child's ClassDojo class as that is how teachers will be communicating class specific announcements and important information.

**Pick Up & Drop Off:** We continue to remind all parents and adults that are dropping off or picking up of our procedures. Parents we ask that you use the designated areas for drop off and pick up.

**Drive through pick up and drop off:** The lane wraps all around the school and should be the **ONLY** lane used in the morning and afternoon for parents that do not wish to park. The line-up is to wrap around the school and then wrap out onto 45th Place. Do not enter the pick up lane from Luane Avenue. **It would be very helpful for Mr. Bailey if you would make a sign with your child/ren's name to place on your dashboard or window at pickup. The lane in front of school is designated for our buses.**

Do **NOT** pull in front of school for drop off or pick up. The only parents that may use the front parking lot and enter campus through the front gate are preschool parents or students in our autism classrooms.

**Park & Pick Up:** For our parents that have chosen the option of parking we ask that you please use the sidewalks and don't walk students through the traffic lane. This is not a safe practice. We would greatly appreciate your cooperation. Finally, I would ask that everyone **slow down** when you are in the area of the school. We have students that are walking and riding their bikes to school and we need everyone's assistance with keeping them safe. Please pay attention to the crossing guard as she is crossing students on 45th Place and Luane Avenue. We also have a crossing guard out on 6E at the crosswalk with flashers.

**21st Century Classes:** Classes begin on September 5th! Monday afternoon session is 2:30-3:30 p.m. and there will be no transportation available on Mondays. Morning sessions are 7:15-8:15 a.m. and the gate will be open from 7:10-7:25 a.m. Once the gate closes, students won't be admitted for class. Afternoon sessions are 3:45-4:45 p.m. Transportation is provided in the afternoon on Tuesday, Wednesday & Thursday.
